Morning Mass on weekdays will facilitate those who have dispensation from Sunday Mass and who wish to attend Mass.

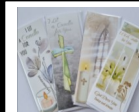
Offertory Collection - In line with public health advice, the collection baskets are no longer be passed among the congregation during Masses; supervised collection buckets are available at the church doors.

Public Health Measures in place as advised by the Government updated on 27th July 2021.

Funerals: The number of mourners permitted at funeral services is 50 people, regardless of size of venue. Attendance at wakes in private homes and at funeral homes is for family only. Related family gatherings should strictly adhere to prevailing public health advice on household mixing, including visitors to your home and indoor and outdoor dining.

Baptisms, Communion and Confirmations: It is advised that religious ceremonies such as First Holy Communion and Confirmations should not take place at this time. Further advice will follow on resumption of these ceremonies when it is safe to do so.

Baptism services are continuing with limited numbers. However, they must follow all protective measures and social gatherings afterwards should be avoided.



Please remember face masks must be worn in the Church.
