Thank you to those who continue to send in their envelopes weekly and to those who use the Standing Order system.

Level 5 restrictions will continue to affect Church Services as detailed below:

1. *Mornington Church will remain open for private prayer from 11am-6pm.*
2. *No Public Masses.*
3. *A maximum of ten people may attend funeral services.*
4. *A maximum of 6 people may attend wedding services.*
5. *Travel, other than essential services and work, is confined to 5km from your home.*
6. *Baptisms are postponed at level 5 as gatherings other than weddings or funerals are not permitted in church or indoors.*
