

### **Church Open for Public Masses - Commencing Tuesday 1st December**

- Following guidelines from the Irish Bishops & the Government our Church has been divided into three sections, each section having it's own entrance/exit.
- Strictly no movement of people between sections before, during or after the service.
- Government guidelines also recommend the wearing of face masks.
- Stewards are available to guide people as they enter & leave the Church and when approaching for Holy Communion.
- People are asked to maintain physical distancing in the Church grounds.
- Holy Communion can only be received in the hand.
- Offertory Collection & Envelopes will be placed in supervised boxes as you enter the Church.
- Bulletins must be brought home and not left in the Church after reading.
- The Church will be cleaned/sanitised after each Mass.
- Toilet facilities will not be available.

It is crucial that all these provisions are adhered to. Indeed, the resumption of public Masses is contingent on such adherence. Please co-operate with the Stewards who are there for your Health, Safety and Welfare.
